

PSEG LI \$400 Smart Charger Rebate for Level 2 Chargers

As of August 1, the rebate to install a 240-volt, Level 2 charger is now \$400 with the PSEG LI *Smart Charger Rebate*. The rebate is available on a first come first served basis for those who are eligible (One port per customer).

Incentive Program

The New York Truck Voucher Incentive Program (NYTVIP), administered by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), provides vouchers (discounts) to commercial fleets, non-profit agencies, and public fleet entities across New York State for the purchase or lease of qualifying medium- and heavy-duty zero-emission battery-electric or hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicles, including trucks, school buses, cargo handling equipment, and transit buses.

A total of \$58.3 million is provided by the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) program and NY's Volkswagen Settlement to fund NYTVIP.

Vouchers for eligible vehicles are available on a first-come, first-served basis through a network of programapproved dealers.
